General:

The Director of Church Engagement connects congregations to our collective ministries as MCM and invites congregations and individuals to support our collective work as MCM through their prayer, participation, and financial resources.

Duties:

Develop and maintain positive relationships with Mennonite Church Manitoba congregations and provide them with information and opportunities related to MCM and MC Canada support and programming. Also, develop and maintain positive relationships with individual donors, including donor recognition and cultivation, in order to achieve our collective MCM goals.

- Regularly visit congregations and church leaders in Manitoba and be present at regional church and other events as appropriate to represent the vision and ministry of Mennonite Church Manitoba and to recruit congregations and donors in support of MCM/MC Canada ministries.
- Work closely with Executive Minister and Ministry Directors to understand MCM congregational ministry interests, initiatives, challenges, and opportunities.
- Work with the MCM staff in the development of strategic promotional, communication, and fundraising tools (e.g. letters, brochures, electronic tools).
- Maintain up-to-date awareness of partnership and resource development strategies, best practices, legal, regulatory, and ethical issues.

Assist in the implementation of Mennonite Church Manitoba's development philosophy and strategies.

- Maintain a profound understanding of and love for the vision, values and ministries of Mennonite Church Manitoba and Canada.
- Oversee the development of MCM fund-raising initiatives.
- Assist MCM congregations to identify and develop healthy and transformative partnerships with other congregations and with MCM staff.
- Prepare reports for the Executive Minister as requested from time to time.

- Broad knowledge of the Mennonite Church Manitoba constituency and eagerness to learn about the MCM constituency in detail.
- Ability to travel frequently within Manitoba.
- Education, experience, and computer skills relevant to the position (minimum undergraduate degree; familiarity with Microsoft Office and database management).
- Church leadership experience and experience in fund-raising are assets.
